Through the New Testament in 26 weeks

This reading scheme will take you through the NT in half a year. The gospels are taken in large portions, while the letters are taken (more or less) a chapter at a time. The scheme does not follow the canonical order of the NT. Instead you will read the writings of Luke, then those of Paul, then those influenced or written by Peter, then those with a stronger Jewish flavour, and finally the writings of John.

The Writings of Luke

Luke wrote his account of the gospel in two volumes: what Jesus began to do and teach and what he continued to do and teach through the apostles. Luke-Acts should be read this way.
